Ascension Sunday

“Joyful Sorrow”

When we look at our church calendar, we discover there are far more days that have special meaning than we customarily consider. I would imagine in a “person on the street” survey, Christmas and Easter would be the only two holidays suggested if people were asked to name Christian holidays.

Even within the church, many would be hard-pressed to go beyond Pentecost as the suggestion of a third holiday. There are, of course, entire “seasons” within the church year – primarily Advent and Lent.

Before Pentecost, though, and after Easter, there is another very special day within the church year that brings those two together. Ascension Sunday is the culmination of the Easter season and the lead-in to Pentecost.

In our day and age, though, the idea of Ascension is nearly as baffling as both Easter and Pentecost! We don’t live in a world that sees things in quite the same way that those of 2,000 years ago saw them. We don’t think of the earth as the center of the universe with heaven being above and hell being below. Our so-called “enlightened” understanding forces us to view things differently and that presents a serious challenge to the way we look at something like the Ascension of Jesus.

Beyond the literal understanding of what took place, though, there are far more important matters to consider – matters that cut to the very heart of our faith. Read Luke 24:44-53 where the disciples offer us the very paradoxical mood of “Joyful Sorrow.”

Thank you to Leslie Webb (Prayer Captain) and to those who committed to being a link in our new chain this past Sunday.


If you have a prayer concern you may submit it by email at epcprayers@gmail.com. This address will be linked immediately to Leslie Webb who will then get your information activated.

EPW RUMMAGE SALE NEWS


This Sunday, May 28

What is Loaves & Fishes?

Loaves and Fishes is a dinner group with time for fellowship.

When & Where is Loaves & Fishes?

Usually there are 8 individuals in a group, couples & singles will be joined to make 8 total in the group. Once groups have been formed, information will be provided to all group members such as names, phone numbers, & e-mails.

The first "host(s)" will be asked to call or e-mail members in their group to set a date, time, & place that works for everyone for the first meal along with requests for allergies (food or pet). Some may have the group of 8 join together to put a meal together in their home, while others may choose to have the group meet for dinner at a local restaurant, it's completely up to you.

At the first meal, someone will agree to be the second host and follow this same procedure throughout the four months. A different member will host the group each month during the next 4 months. We will have two Loaves & Fishes per year so feel free to meet as often as your group would like in the 4-6 months.

The purpose of Loaves & Fishes is to share a meal and spend an evening getting to know other members of our church. There is no agenda, just an evening of fellowship and food. Fun! Food! Fellowship!!!
