"Why Me?"

PASTOR This past Sunday – New Year's Day – Barb Ferguson led us in worship for the beginning of the New Year and Epiphany Sunday. While you were worshiping here at East-

minster, Emma Sue and I were worshiping at New Hope Presbyterian Church in Fishers, Indiana. We were in the middle of the row (not pew), with Drew and Marie on one side of us and David and Kelsie on the other. Emmett (age 3) and Asher (age 1) were first on one side and then the other and then in the middle. Those of you who do or have worshiped with children understand what I mean! What a great way to begin the New Year for us and I'm so thankful to Barb for providing such an opportunity.

This Sunday is designated as Baptism of the Lord Sunday, which seems rather odd since we have just completed our celebration of the birth of Jesus and then the visit of the Wise Men. That wouldn't be at all odd if baptism at the time of Jesus was practiced as we ordinarily do. His baptism would have taken place shortly after his birth. We know, though, that Jesus was baptized at about the age of 30 and he was baptized by his cousin John, known to us as John the Baptist.

When we focus on the baptism of Jesus, we usually center on the last half of the passage that addresses it – the part where the baptism itself takes place with all of its miraculous surrounding events. We have the parting of the clouds, the descent of the dove and the heavenly declaration from God.

This Sunday, though, I'd like to look at the first half of the passage – the part where John initially objects because he's not really worthy to be doing so.

There's a reason for that being our focus this Sunday. This Sunday is also Ordination & Installation of new officers and I think it fits perfectly with the passage of Jesus' baptism.

I think we can see a logical connection between that event and the second half of the passage, but focusing on the first half makes it a bit more personal for me.

I think it fits for our new officers as well and I think it really fits for every one of us in the way God calls us to serve in some capacity.

Read the account of the Baptism of Jesus in Matthew 3:13-17. There's a question that many of us ask at various times of life. It's a question that's ordinarily asked in a negative fashion. The same question, though, can be asked in an almost exact opposite fashion and I think this passage offers a very helpful answer to that way of asking it. The question is "Why Me?"

Will you be governed by our church's polity, and will you abide by its discipline? Will you be a friend among your colleagues in ministry, working with them, subject to the ordering of God's Word and Spirit?
