For them this is a profound question and they ask it in such a way that suggests that we believers have never considered it. God never promised us that if we led a Christ-like life and believed in Him that we would be exempt from hard-ships and disaster.

Our scripture reading this Sunday is Isaiah 65:17-25, a promise not to protect us from the calamities of life, but a promise to give us life in a world worthy of our God. As you meditate on this passage this week, think of the difference between the thought process of one who poses this entitled question and our thought process as believers. To put it simply they are caught up in the short game while others are playing the long game. We trust in the teachings of Jesus Christ and we have accepted that although bad things happen to good people, our God has given us the endurance to persevere.
