Update on our Transitional Pastor Search

Last month we provided information about the Transitional Pastor Search process that began in January. In this month's update, we will explain a bit more about the transitional pastor position.

The purpose of the transitional pastor job is to provide full-time pastoral leadership while our church transitions from our time when Reverend Davenport served as our senior pastor to our time when our next permanent senior pastor will be installed.

The average time churches spend searching for a permanent senior pastor is about 12 months, sometimes longer. This time is needed to conduct a thorough process of finding a pastor who will have the right "fit" for Eastminster's spiritual needs and direction. The transitional pastor will help provide Eastminster with the spiritual leadership and stability we need during the time we are searching for a new permanent senior pastor.

The transitional pastor position is a special calling for those who are called to it. There are two key differences between a transitional pastor and a permanent pastor. First, it is a temporary position. The transitional pastor will be hired on a short-term basis of about 12 months, until the search for our next senior pastor is completed. Second, the transitional pastor is not eligible to be considered for the permanent pastor.

Transitional pastors perform many of the same job duties as a permanent pastor: leading worship and preaching biblically-based sermons, serving as head of church staff, administering the sacraments, providing pastoral care, and so forth. In addition, those who have been called to serve as transitional pastors typically have received specialized training to deal with various types of issues and needs of churches undergoing transition in leadership.

Eastminster's Transitional Pastor Search Committee is continuing to make progress on the search for Eastminster's transitional pastor. Although similar in many ways to the search for a permanent pastor, the search process for a transitional pastor will be considerably shorter.
