I began to notice that although there are many great men in the bible who not only paved the way for us to enter into a deeper experience of God, many of these men had astonishingly questionable shortcomings as both Godly men and as fathers. As a young man with no children, cannot personally speak to what it means to be a father. However, I think every moment in the work of a father is defined by one quality more than any other. Integrity. As I observed the fathers found in the Bible and the ones I encounter in my everyday life, I found that every positive result a father produces is born from his integrity regarding his family, and the negative results stem from an absence of it. As we celebrate all of the men who have worked long hours to support us, made hard choices on our behalf, and who have instilled in us the correct morals that help us stand before God as Christians, read and reflect on Proverbs 4:25-27.


