

From the Pulpit

"Who Do You Think You Are?"

I can't help but ask myself this question every time it is my turn to preach. A big reason for this is that I have spent my entire life at Eastminster. Members of this congregation were my Sunday school teachers, my Bible study leaders, and in many were my mentors. As an unqualified and inexperienced young man, I cannot express how difficult it is to stand behind a pulpit and look out at the very people who taught me everything I know about the Bible and try to share something meaningful with them - especially when more often than not the message I am trying to share is one that one of you has already, either knowingly or unknowingly, shared with me! These last few months have launched me into a crisis of identity and position. I often think of the story of Samson, a man who often found himself doing things he had no business doing. Although his story is not a perfect metaphor for my experience, it at times is one that I find relatable. Reflect on Judges 13:1-15 and Samson's story; think about what God is calling you to do in this final stop of great transition.

Introducing the Reverend Dr. Scott V. Solether

Reverend Solether will join us on September 1 as our new Transitional Pastor.

Born and raised in Ohio, he is no stranger to the Midwest. Reverend Solether is a graduate of Asbury College in

Wilmore, Kentucky, with a major in Christian Education and a Vocal Performance Minor. He did his graduate work at Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary and holds a doctoral degree from the Institute for Worship Studies in Orange Park, Florida.

Over his 36 years of ministry, Dr. Solether has served churches in Michigan (White Pigeon and Palmyra), West Virginia (Moundsville), Tennessee (Jonesborough), Indiana (Portland), Kansas (Great Bend), and North Carolina (Rocky Mount). For much of that time he was an installed pastor. He has also served as a Designated pastor and entered the interim ministry several years ago.

Missions have always been a part of his ministry. Dr. Solether has taken mission trips to Brazil, the Philippines, Mexico, and Alaska as well as trips around the country.

Pastor Solether is married to Tammy and has three adult children - Brandon, Kenton, and Cameron. Tammy and Scott are blessed to have three grandchildren - Chucky, Chase, and Persephone.

Coming to Evansville for the Solethers is like coming home. Tammy's family live in New Albany, Indiana, and they look forward to being closer to them and to their son and grandchildren in Illinois. Though Dr. Solether is a temporary pastor, he looks forward to ministering with Eastminster and getting to know each of you.


