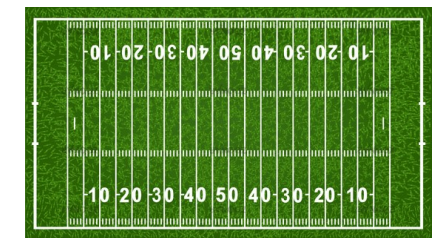
- Individuals need to be fever free for 24 hours before returning to church activities
