"An Andrew Ministry" 2nd Sunday After Epiphany

Peter is the most recognizable of Jesus' followers. He was consid-

ered the leader of the disciples and the head of the early church. In contrast, Peter's brother Andrew is rarely mentioned in the Bible. Most of what we know about Andrew comes from the Gospel of John. Andrew was best known for bringing people to Jesus. Beginning with his brother, Andrew led people into the presence of Jesus. It was Andrew who brought the boy who had the fish and loaves, and it was Andrew who during the Passover Feast brought a group of Greeks (Gentiles) to meet Jesus which prompts Jesus to remark "when I am lifted up from the earth I will draw all to myself." He was probably not a great orator nor was he seen as a talented leader. Andrew knew that Jesus came not only to save Israel but everyone on the earth and he made it his mission to invite others to know Christ. You may not be a preacher or a leader, but the greatest ministry of all is to be an inviting Christian. "Come and see what God is doing", should become our invitation to everyone. Having an "Andrew" ministry can be one of the most effective evangelism program available.


