This Sunday, July 5th, we will have Rev. Wendy McCormick as our guest preach-



In His Service, Finance Committee

Dear Eastminster Family,

On April 22 of this year, your session approved our Mission Study report. The committee that created this report took input from the congregation and created a comprehensive document outlining the direction Eastminster wants to go in the future. This document was then passed on to the Presbytery Committee on Ministry (COM) along with our request to form a Pastoral Nominating Committee (PNC). On June 2, the COM response to this request was to postpone taking action. They acknowledged the insightfulness of the mission study but felt that the fastest way for EPC to acquire a pastoral leader was through another transitional or "gap" pastor. The COM believes that trained, ordained leadership is crucial during this transition time and the search for an installed pastor could take a year or more. Since much of the work to find a transitional pastor was done just last year, this route would be most effective.

On June 17, the session called a meeting to discuss this response from the COM. Many concerns were raised by many members of session regarding yet another delay in our ability to form a PNC, the first step in finding our next installed pastor. In the end we voted to elect a new transitional pastor search committee composed of five members of session, plus one alternate: Pam Doerter, Annie Engelbrecht, Shannon Irmscher, Chris Kuhs, Mark Miller, and Patsy Sproatt as alternate. This committee has already met to update Eastminster's Ministry Information Form (MIF), which will be available to potential interim pastoral candidates. This search should take considerably less time than last year's because much of the work has already been done.

We also want you to know that this committee is very motivated to expedite this search process as much as we can. Colossians 3:23 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters." Once this new transitional pastor is in place, a PNC will be formed soon after.

We know this news may come as a disappointment to many of you, as it did to many of us, but the reason we are *all* still here is for each other. The congregation of Eastminster Presbyterian Church is a group of loving, supportive, encouraging, caring, and compassionate followers of Christ.

We will get through this, and we will find the pastor God has in mind for us. Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
