Sympathy is extended to Tracy Wingerter and Dion Smith in the death of their father, Robert Alexander Smith, who passed away on September 29, 2020.



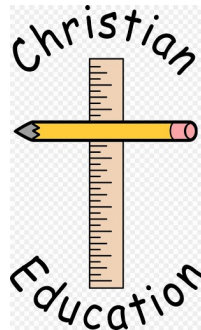
