Our Interim Pastor

Read Ephesians 4:25-5:2.

This is a passage from last week's lectionary that I didn't choose as a the text for preaching. Sometimes a passage or a story simply preaches itself and needs no further explanation. I appreciate the no-nonsense approach used to remind people to

be good to each other. Sometimes even bad movies have a good message for us.

One such movie from several years ago was "Bill and Ted's Excellent Adventure." The lackluster sequel was called "Bill and Ted's Bogus Journey," and just last year older actors who once played teenagers in the earlier movies played older versions of themselves in "Bill and Ted Face the Music." I have not seen this movie yet, but it actually received rather good reviews from fans and critics alike. What the characters are most known for is their two part catch phrase "Be excellent to each other" and "Party on, dudes."

While the first part of that might make more sense in light of the Ephesians reading, you may be wondering why the second phrase of "party on dudes" has relevance in a Christian context. The Westminster catechism is sometimes used to help people new to the faith learn about its central beliefs. Its first question/answer is, "What is the chief end of man? Man's chief end is to glorify God and enjoy him forever." You see, enjoying God and the life God gives us is part of our very purpose and perhaps is what helps us most to be good to one another.


