Several years ago, before I had children in school, one of the large office retailers had a television commercial showing a man skating and gliding a shopping cart through a store gleefully picking up school supplies. His neardance maneuvers were set to the soundtrack of a man crooning: "It's the

most wonderful time of the year." Meanwhile the onlooking children wore dour expressions. This ad stays in my memory because it made me laugh, and that was because it was creative. I knew that I had been those children, and wondered if I would one day become that parent?

Please note: photos will not be returned.




