The Eastminster Quilters continue to meet every Tuesday morning and to be productive while enjoying good fellowship. We are machine quilters not hand quilters, and make throw-sized quilts only. We feel that instead of "heirlooms" our quilts are to be used regularly as a token of the warmth of Christ's love.

This has been a learning year for the quilters. Our newer members have made good progress and we welcomed another who is new to quilting. We took several breaks from actual quilting to learn new techniques: Made zippered tote bags to carry our supplies, made book weights to give as favors, and for EPW's Christmas lunch made decorative napkin/utensil holders, again as favors.

Fourteen quilts were presented. Two to newborns (friends of the congregation); three to individuals during illnesses; one to a new member moving into assisted living; one to a young man in crisis; one to a family flooded out of their home temporarily, one to Reverend Silence as he moved on to his new pastorate; and the final five as a donation to the Mt. Vernon Rehabilitation Center.

The Quilting room is open Tuesday mornings from 9:00 am to Noon and we welcome new members at any level of sewing skill. We thank the Community and World Missions Committee for the financial support that allows us to maintain our equipment and purchase the materials needed for our projects. You can help by letting us (or the office) know of congregation members or friends of the church we may not be aware of who are in circumstances where a quilt would be appropriate.
