Recent months have proven to Eastminster that longer term help is greatly needed both inside and outside of our church.

The committee has been meeting on a weekly basis to develop assessment applications and evaluation procedures to cover what the committee can and can not do. Some of things that they are working on are:

- 1. Food Bank
- 2. Rides for members to and from appointments, etc.
- 3. Counseling
- 4. Help with utilities and rent which goes beyond what Deacons are able to do
- 5. Other un-conventional needs

Funding has not been established as of yet, but the Ministry isn't letting that slow them down. There will be several fundraisers in the near future to help get funding established. In the meantime, if you are in need of any of the above services, please contact the church office where arrangements will be made for you. If you would like to contribute ideas and/or suggestions call those in as well.


