Our own Rick Zeiher will be on hand to discuss the capsule and its contents.



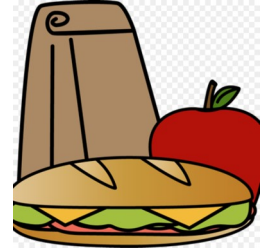
