What is a Prayer Chain?

A prayer chain is a group of people committed to praying for a specific reason or person for a pre-determined period of time. Typically, a prayer chain starts with one person who shares a prayer need with the group, then the request is passed along to the members of the group to pray over.

Asking for Prayer:

If you are in need of prayer, all you need to do is contact the office at 812-476-3355 or fill out the prayer card located in the church pew, an envelope will also be provided for confidentiality, then drop in the offering plate. Please include as much information you think is needed. Updates on the situation are not required but are recommended.
