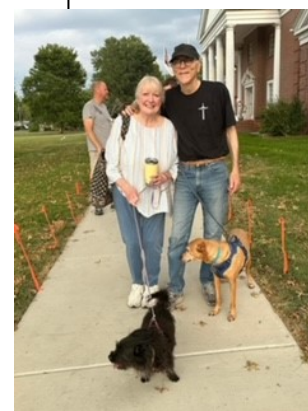

When and where is the Halloween Carnival?

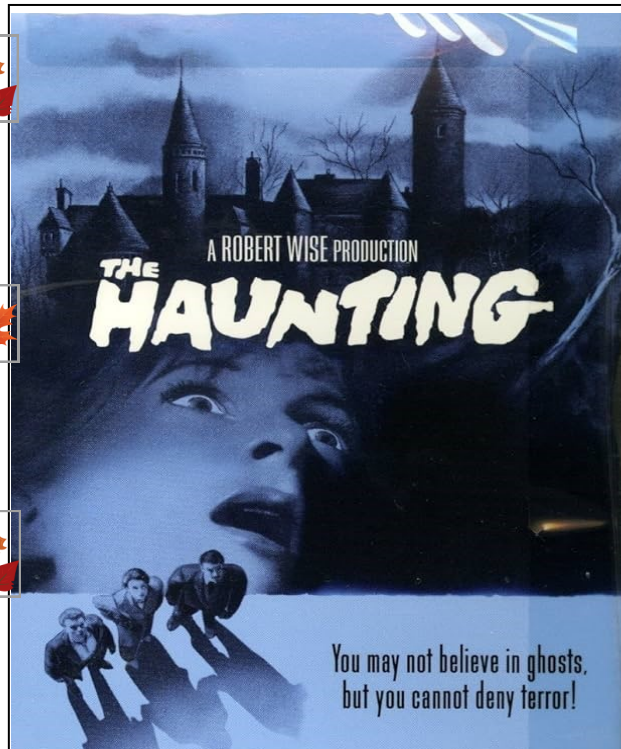
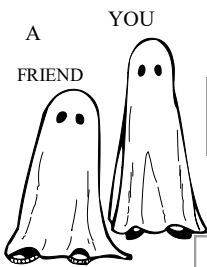
This year our Halloween Carnival will be Sunday, October 27 at 11:30 a.m. in the fellowship hall of the church.
