I'd love to hear Sarah Josepha Hale tell stories about what she's learned about

persistence, the faith , and people that have inspired her to carry on. We might remember reading that it was Sarah who through her writing and advocacy, persisted for decades calling for a national day of thanksgiving, writing every governor, and eventually President Lincoln.

Finally in 1863, aided by the writing of Secretary of State, William Seward, Lincoln set a proclamation for a "day for National thanksgiving, praise, and prayer".

Remarkable how Seward's words continue to speak today, calling upon God to "invoke the influence of His Holy Spirit to subdue the anger", to visit with tender care and consolation", and fervently implore...the Almighty...to heal the wounds of the nation".

Sarah Josepha Hale's persistence proved fruitful even through what must have been lengthy seasons of waiting. It is my prayer for you that as you move through Thanksgiving into the season of hopeful waiting of Advent in Christ that the transformative good news of Jesus as beautifully told by Luke, the growing awareness of past persistence that has graced our lives, and the Spirit all deeply encourage you in the Way of Jesus with hope, peace, joy and love.


Thanksgiving Processional 2024
