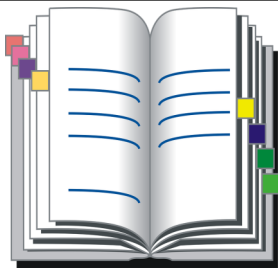

Small group for young adults who want to enjoy God, grow as active followers of Jesus, and make life-changing friendships.

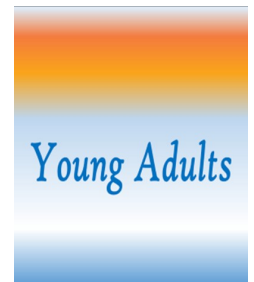
All post high school age, 20's, 30's, and 40's are invited.

Eastminster and its Deacons have been fortunate to fund a Christmas basket program for over 25 years.

This year, our partnering agency, Residential Aurora, has requested 25 Tote Family Baskets. The item donations will help to meet the desperate need that families are feeling right now. To help the Deacons reach the goal, we have set updates of giving.

November 2 For Paper Products: Suggestions---paper towels, toilet paper, Band-aids, napkins (we have Kleenex.)

November 9 For Cleaning Products: Suggestions---Clorox-type wipes, scouring or bathroom/kitchen, cleaners.

November 16 For Toiletries, etc.: Suggestions---deodorant, toothbrushes/toothpaste, bodywash, shampoo, Scotch tape, post-it notes (we have hands soap.)

November 23 For Kitchen/Laundry: Suggestions---detergent, softener, dish soap

November 30 For any donations
