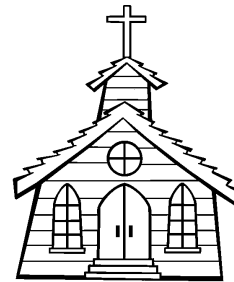

RE: Temporary Housing/Rental of (Ground Floor Classrooms)
DATE: August 6, 2026

Our church was approached by the owner of 'World Harvest Ministries' (Jessica Greulich) after they had experienced a devastating fire that occurred to their building approximately (6) weeks ago. Her ministry (child-care operation) serves up to (40) young people – ages (6) months to (13) years of age.

This would be a temporary arrangement (6 months – 1 year) with a monthly rental fee of (\$750.00).

Many hours have been spent in discussion, vetting of Ms. Greulich and her operation, resolving any insurance concerns, and a 'legal lease agreement' drawn up by an attorney.

There have been 'numerous moving parts' and a 'time-sensitive urgency' involving this matter as well.

After careful deliberation, Building & Maintenance approached Session with a formal proposal to assist 'World Harvest Ministries' in allowing her to utilize the ground-floor classrooms for her ministry. This proposal was accepted by a majority vote of Session.
